Ash Wednesday - Feb. 13th

Holy... We begin the Holy Season of Lent this week on **Ash Wed.** It is a day of fast and abstinence [one full meal, two **Season...** snacks]. The Friday's of Lent are days of abstinence, with the exception of Good Friday, which is a day of **of Lent...** and abstinence. Traditionally just about every Catholic likes to begin the Holy Season of Lent by going to mass.

Lent At... During the Holy Season of Lent we will have in addition to our regular daily Mass schedule, The Way of the **St. Peter...** Cross, Holy Communion, and a short meditation followed by a light supper, probably soup, salad & fellowship.
