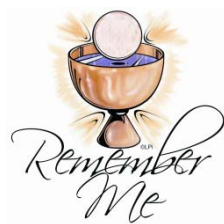

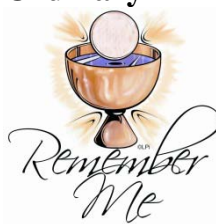

The beginning of the Lenten Season starts with Ash Wednesday, February 17th.

***Ash Wednesday is a day of universal fast and abstinence in the Church.

Distribution of Ashes: While Ash Wednesday is not a holy day of obligation and while there is no requirement for the clergy and faithful to receive the imposition of ashes, it is rightly observed as a celebration of high importance, and many will surely wish to participate even amid the current difficulties. During this time of pandemic, the Holy See has modified the method of distributing the ashes, as outlined in the following "note":

"The Priest says the prayer for blessing the ashes. He sprinkles the ashes with holy water, without saying anything. Then he addresses all those present and only once says the formula as it appears in the Roman Missal, applying it to all in general: "Repent, and believe in the Gospel", or "Remember that you are dust, and to dust you shall return". The priest then cleanses his hands, puts on a face mask and distributes the ashes by sprinkling them on the head of each one without saying anything.
