During Masses:

**Altar Servers:** The current updated COVID-19 regulations allow the use of altar servers. We will not be assigning altar servers, but anyone who wishes to serve may volunteer. Altar servers who are youth or adults that are unvaccinated are required to wear masks and are asked to arrive early to be prepared to serve.

Therefore, someone can validly make the decision to attend Mass during the week, if able, and to participate in the Mass on the Lord's Day through live streaming.
