LITURGICAL MINISTERS

Due to COVID-19 regulations and until further notice, we are not using Eucharistic ministers. We are not currently assigning Lectors either. We kindly ask that anyone who is a Lector that attends a Mass is prepared to read. We appreciate your support and willingness to serve in this matter.

Altar Servers: The current updated COVID-19 regulations allow the use of altar servers. We will not be assigning altar servers, but anyone who wishes to serve may volunteer. Altar servers who are youth or adults that are unvaccinated are required to wear masks and are asked to arrive early to be prepared to serve.

Dispensation Ends

The Dispensation from Sunday Mass will end on the Feast of Corpus Christi, Saturday and Sunday, June 5th & 6th. The Sunday obligation will be restored on this great feast when we can satisfy our hunger for the Bread of Life, in Word and Sacrament with the reception of Holy Communion. Keep in mind that the Church always dispenses from the Sunday obligation when any of the faithful are confronting serious health concerns. Therefore, someone can validly make the decision to attend Mass during the week, if able, and to participate in the Mass on the Lord's Day through live streaming.

He and his younger brother are currently both suffering from a cold and his sister who was caring for their father is quite lonely.
