Business was steady at our church food pantry for the year of 2020. Closing our doors from May 1<sup>st</sup> until June 30<sup>th</sup> due to the city wide stay at home orders, we still served a total of 406 needy individuals.

The year 2021 has seen an increase in the number of needy coming to our food pantry. From January to June 30<sup>th</sup> we have helped over 504 individuals.
