Reminder of Updated COVID protocols:

In light of the increase in COVID-19 cases and hospitalizations in Mississippi and throughout the country due to the Delta variant of the virus, the Diocese of Jackson has updated our current protocols.

During Mass social distancing needs to be maintained at a minimum of 3 feet and hand sanitizer should be used upon entering the church. Masks are encouraged, especially for those individuals with compromised immune systems or other underlying health concerns.
