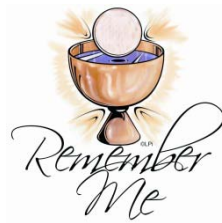

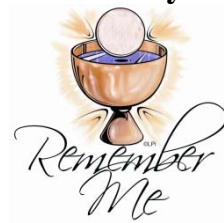

St Peter's Food Pantry Update:

Business continues as usual at our church food pantry as we were able to serve over 255 individuals from November 1, 2021 through January 31, 2022. This included families, elderly and the homeless. Many of these families and elderly were being helped with food stamps in 2021, but their amount has been decreased, for some as low as \$10-\$20 per month total. They are finding it hard to make ends meet and are very grateful for what we can do to help them here at St Peter's.

Hunger is often misunderstood. Hunger is not starvation. Hunger is a single mother with two children or grandparents caring for their grandchildren having to choose between groceries or needed medications, deciding between rent, utilities or food. Regardless of where you live, hunger can be a problem. One of the big challenges of hunger is that it's an easily hidden problem. You could have a neighbor or a friend dealing with food insecurity and you're not going to know about it. It's not obvious a lot of times. People with food insecurity often go out of their way to conceal their problem. The statistics point to the fact that there are good insecure people in every community. With the increase in food prices we can see an increase in those in need as the year progresses.

We are more than grateful to all who have donated, in the way of money, food or service, to help our food pantry continue to reach out to those in need in our community. This ministry could not continue without the help of everyone. Thank you!
