"Very truly, I tell you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink his blood, you have no life in you" (John 6:53) In that statement, Jesus maintains the potency of his rhetoric by doubling down and using an even stronger Greek word for "eat", which translates a "gnaw" in English.
