Quarterly Report**

During the last quarter, July 1st through September 30th, we have served 335 individuals. This large number represents the elderly, the homeless, as well as entire families. Although we were closed for two days due to holidays, we continued to see a steady rise in the number of people in need coming through our door.

Our Food Pantry inventory depletes much faster now than it did in the past. Unfortunately, we felt it best to decrease a few food items from our monthly food bag distributions. It is just a small change, but it does make a difference, financially.

Those who come seeking help are thankful for all that we can offer them, in food, as well as clothing. We are always in need of gently worn women's, men's (especially pants), and children's clothing. With winter approaching, blankets would be an added blessing!

I know we are all experiencing the rise in the cost of food, along with everything else. So much more are those who have far less than we do and come to our Food Pantry in need of some relief. All that we do is made possible through the generous help with food, clothes, and monetary donations from you, our Parish Family.
